Participation on the project „PATHS TO EXPERIENCE“


Dear ladies and gentlemen,

We would like to introduce and offer you participation on the project "PATHS TO EXPERIENCE," which focuses on linking practice and theory – commercial sector and education sector. The main goal of this project is to **connect successful companies in the field of energy-efficient construction and talented Czech master's degree students** in relevant field (for example **in architecture or construction field**). Our partners are five universities from the Czech Republic. Student's long-term or short-term stays in companies are one of the key activities of this project.

These student's stays in companies should take **4 or 12 weeks**. The benefits would be two-sided: on the one hand students will acquire practical skills in high-quality companies; on the other hand involved companies will gain new business ideas and establish cooperation with relevant university in the Czech Republic. The company will receive for each student's educational training amount of € 1.000 – as a reward for employee who will intensively supervise the student during his stay at the company. **Master's degree students from [Faculty of Architecture – Brno University of Technology](#)** will apply for practice in international companies, i.e. in your company, with the beginning of December 2013. First student's stays can take place **from January 2013**. More information about the project you can find in the enclosure "Brief description of cooperation within the project."
